HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING PASS APPLICATION

Va. Code § 22.1-205.1: Each public high school shall require any student who applies to obtain a pass to park a vehicle on school property to provide evidence that the student possesses a valid driver's license or driver privilege card. The Department of Education shall develop, and each public high school shall utilize, a standard application form for students to use to obtain a pass to park a vehicle on school property.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Teen Driving Restrictions

Virginia's driving restrictions are not meant to penalize teen drivers, but to help them stay safe while they gain valuable driving experience. Studies have found that these restrictions work to reduce the number of car crashes among young drivers.

Curfew Restrictions

If you are under age 18, Virginia law prohibits you from driving between midnight and 4 A.M. except when driving:

- to or from a place of business where you are employed;
- to or from an activity that is supervised by an adult and is sponsored by a school or by a civic, religious, or public organization;
- with a licensed spouse age 18 or older, parent or other adult acting in loco parentis who is occupying the front passenger seat,
- in case of an emergency, including responding to emergency calls as a volunteer firefighter or rescue squad personnel.

Restrictions on the Number of Passengers

If you are under age 18, you may carry only one passenger under age 21, unless accompanied by a licensed parent, or other adult acting in place of a parent, in the front passenger seat. However, after you have held your license for one year, you may carry up to three passengers under age 21 in the following situations:

- Travel to and from a school-sponsored activity;
- A licensed driver 21 or older is in the front passenger seat; or
- In case of an emergency.

Learner's permit holders may not carry more than one passenger under age 18.
(Passenger restrictions do not apply to family members)

Cellular Telephone Restrictions

§ 46.2-818.2. Virginia's cellular telephone law prohibits any person from holding a handheld personal communications device while driving a moving motor vehicle on the highways in the Commonwealth.

**ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR
PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

1. ALL CARS PARKED ON SCHOOL GROUNDS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE SCHOOL AND DISPLAY A CURRENT PARKING PERMIT. CARS NOT DISPLAYING A CURRENT PARKING PERMIT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARK ON SCHOOL GROUNDS. UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES PARKED ON SCHOOL GROUNDS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE.
2. ALL STUDENTS MUST BE LICENSED AND COVERED BY INSURANCE. THE VEHICLE MUST MEET ALL LOCAL AND STATE REQUIREMENTS. THE SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE AUTOMOBILE OR ITS CONTENTS.
3. ALL RULES ON THE ROAD MUST BE ADHERED TO WHILE DRIVING TO OR FROM SCHOOL GROUNDS. NO SPEEDING OR ANY FORM OF RECKLESS DRIVING WILL BE TOLERATED.
4. STUDENT VEHICLES MAY BE SUBJECT TO SEARCH IF THERE ARE REASONABLE GROUNDS TO BELIEVE DRUGS, ALCOHOL, WEAPONS, STOLEN PROPERTY, OR OTHER CONTRABAND MIGHT BE PRESENT IN VEHICLE.
5. STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SELL, GIVE AWAY, OR ALLOW OTHER STUDENTS TO USE THEIR PARKING PERMIT.
6. WHEN SELLING, TRADING, OR DRIVING SUBSTITUTE VEHICLES, NOTIFY THE SECURITY OFFICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
7. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EVERY STUDENT WHO DRIVES TO SCHOOL TO REPORT ON TIME. ANY STUDENT WHO FREQUENTLY REPORTS LATE TO SCHOOL MAY LOSE THE PRIVILEGE OF PARKING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS AND FACES FURTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION WHICH MAY INCLUDE SUSPENSION. ANY VIOLATION OF PARKING REGULATIONS MAY RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING: SUSPENSION OF PARKING PRIVILEGES FOR PART OR ALL OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL, TOWING OF VEHICLE, OR LEGAL ACTION.
8. PARKING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS WHILE PERMIT IS REVOKED WILL RESULT IN 30 ADDITIONAL DAYS OF PARKING REVOCATION AND/OR OTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

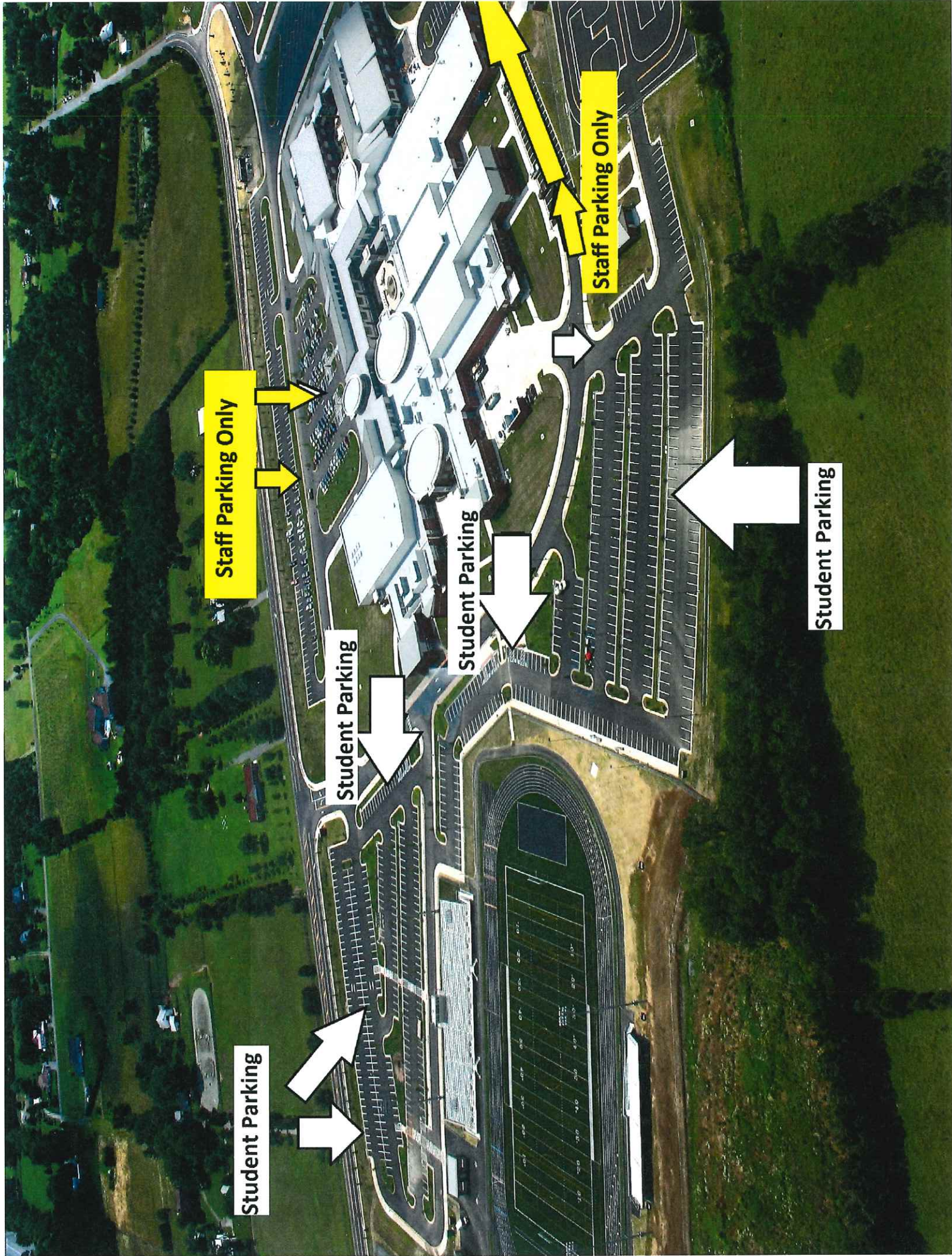

2023-24 Student Parking at Patriot High School

Only licensed drivers are eligible to receive a parking pass. You must bring the completed parking application to receive a parking pass. Student parking passes are issued by School Safety and Security Officer, Mr. Murphy. The student parking pass fee is \$100 and can be paid by cash, check, or electronically, [StudentQuickPay.com](https://www.studentquickpay.com). For electronic payment, you must create an account first. Be sure to print out your receipt and attach it to the application if paying electronically. Parking pass applications can be dropped off in the Patriot main office beginning on 8/7/23 and will be announced on the Patriot website. Students can purchase parking passes throughout the school year. For seniors, the parking pass fee is reduced to \$50 if purchased after the first semester. If a parking pass is purchased after spring break, the parking pass fee will be waived for the next upcoming year, but another parking application must be completed and submitted.

Listed below are the requirements to drive and park your vehicle at Patriot High School:

- Drivers must be fully licensed and possess insurance to purchase a permit.
- Drivers and passengers who arrive after the tardy bell must enter school thru the main entrance and check in with Attendance. Failure to do so may result in a revocation of parking privileges.
- Students must purchase and display a parking hangtag by obtaining and completing the Student Parking Application. Vehicles not displaying valid hangtags will be subject to being towed at the owner's expense.
- Students may **not** return to their vehicles for any reason unless permission has been granted by **security staff or an administrator and they must use Door 1 to exit and re-enter school.**
- Any student **leaving the school property** in their vehicle without signing out will **lose privileges** to park on the lot for a specified period to be determined by the principal or his designee.
- Students reported and confirmed to be driving in a reckless manner while traveling to or from school will be subject to a loss of driving privileges.
- Students that drive on school property must use caution and obey posted signs. Students that drive recklessly or fail to obey traffic rules may lose parking privileges or be referred to the Prince William County Police.
- All vehicles are subject to search if there is **reasonable suspicion** that **drugs, alcohol, weapons, stolen property**, or other **contraband** may be present.
- Students will lose their parking pass and permission to park on school property if the hangtag is copied, sold, or transferred to another student.
- Security must be notified immediately if a substitute vehicle is driven.
- Lost hangtags shall be reported to security and a new hangtag will be issued for a \$5 replacement fee.
- Students may only park in those spots designated as student parking. Violators may be warned, disciplined, or towed. A parking map is included with the parking application and is visible on the school web page. Students shall not park in staff parking spaces.
- Student drivers who are tardy to school may receive the following consequences:
 - **Five (5) tardy arrivals to school: Morning detention and warning for loss of parking pass**
 - **Ten (10) tardy arrivals to school: Loss of parking pass for 10 days**
 - **Fifteen (15) tardy arrivals to school: Loss of parking privileges for 30 days AND tardy probation (five (5) additional tardy arrivals to school will result in immediate loss of parking privileges for remainder of grading period).**
