COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA

VERIFY PLACEMENT FOR COURSES

Students who have graduated from high school less than five years ago will submit high school transcripts and/or if available, GED, SAT, ACT, AP, IB, TOEFL, or ILETS-Academic scores to Northern Virginia Community College. Unofficial copies of transcripts and test scores are acceptable for placement purposes. For alternative remote placement guidance, visit our Remote Placement Page.
