Regulation 661-3, Assessment and Grading Practices-High

As shared in the last newsletter, Patriot HS continues to focus on the learning and achievement of all students. With that, parents and students should review the regulation, read the syllabus for each of their classes, and be familiar with the grading scale. These directly relate to our retake and assessment process for students for the coming school year. More information will be shared during the first weeks of school.

Attendance

One of the primary indicators of student success is attendance. In accordance with the PWCS Strategic plan, one of our initiatives is to improve student attendance in order to promote academic success for our students. Now, it has been found, as shared on the PWCS website, "Chronic absenteeism, missing more than 10% of the school year *for any reason*, has been associated with lower reading and math achievement in elementary grades, and class failure and drop out at the secondary level."

To achieve <u>Commitment 2: Positive Climate and Culture's Objective 2.1</u> of the Strategic Plan, Patriot will "engage students and parents, recognize good and improved attendance, monitor attendance data, provide personalized early outreach, and develop programmatic response to barriers" as outlined.

Patriot's administration will be sharing specific information during the first weeks of school.
