



Patriot High School Senior Customized Parking Spot Application/Packet

As a senior at Patriot High School, you have the privilege of customizing your parking spot. Choosing to decorate your space allows you to not only personalize your space but creates a dedicated parking spot for you during school hours. The community may use your spot after school hours and during school events.

Please remember this is a celebratory chapter of your life, so encourage designs that focus on high school accomplishments, passions, hobbies, athletic or activity participation, or future steps, such as colleges and careers. Please note spaces are limited and first come **first serve**.

To get approved for a customized parking spot, senior students must complete all of the following by August 22th for the application to be considered and accepted. Completed applications should be turned into Mrs. Hughes (2003) or Mrs. Lenahan (1304). Late applications WILL not be accepted.

- Have Obtained a Patriot Parking Permit
- Complete the parking design request application
- Submit the \$40 painting fee to student QuickPay (must show receipt of payment)

Painting Day/window: ONLY after receiving administrator approved application, senior student may paint to their assigned parking spot. Painting will be permitted between 2:00-7pm on August 29th (painting day). It will also be permitted August 30th-September 26th, but NOT DURING SCHOOL HOURS. *Note: students must be off school grounds by 7pm on August 29th and students are not permitted to leave any painting supplies overnight.*

Customized Senior Parking Spot Guidelines:

- Parking lines may not be painted over - tape must be applied to your space to create clean lines and a 6-inch gap between lines and parking space number
- Parking space designs must be approved by the administration before painting.
- No inappropriate abbreviations (examples of acceptable abbreviations: 2k24, PHS, Colleges, etc...)
- Must abide by Prince William County School Regulations and Code of Behavior
- No slanderous or obscene wording (including curse words and or phrases/symbols) may be used
- Administration has the right to ask any student to remove any inappropriate designs at any time for any reason. **If your design changes in ANY way between its approval and painting, you will be required to paint over the design at your expense.*
- Only exterior all-weather paint may be used on the parking spaces. This should be water-based, Low VOC, paint and not an oil-based paint. We suggest you talk the paint department about what you are doing and let them help you with paints, how much to purchase, and colors.
- All paint and supplies must be provided by the student and must be taken home every day. **Any paint/supplies left at the parking spot will result in a one-week suspension of the parking pass.**
- You must bring in your own water source, no school facilities may be used to clean paintbrushes etc.
- Your Patriot Parking Pass number must be painted in the bottom right corner of your spot.

Painting Day: August 29th 2pm-7pm

Note: no student is permitted before 2pm

- You must supply your own paint and giant brushes or rollers, pain can opener, paint trays
- You must leave 6 inches from the parking lot line and the top number on the spot
- You must include you 4-digit parking pass number at the bottom right of your parking spot
- **No air or airless paint sprayers are permitted, NO spray paint**
- Parking lines may not be painted over – tape must be applied to your space to create clean lines and a 4-inch gap between lines and parking space number

Helpful tips:

- You will have to buy paint in gallons for the background, so it is suggested you discuss with friends to share your colors. You may want to buy pints for detail in colors. If you want a completely solid background, then get more than one gallon. Don't forget to buy paint and a can opener.
- **Chalk:** Use chalk to draw what you want to paint on the solid background and to trace any writing.

I hereby agree to abide by all the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a painted parking space:

- I will only paint within the approved parameters of my space (see Design Request Sheet)
- I will only paint my approved design.
- I will only use water-based exterior latex paint. No spray paint, reflective paint or fluorescent paint of any kind will be used.
- I understand that the school will not supply any items to me. I must supply my own brushes, paint and any other necessary supplies. I agree to clean up all supplies.
- I will park only in my assigned parking space, and I will notify administration if someone else is parked in my parking space during school hours.
- I understand that my painted design must be completed after 3:00 pm on school days or on the weekends by September 21, 2025. I agree to clean up all supplies.
- I understand that failure to abide by any rules, regulations or guidelines may result in forfeiture of my parking space and my design may be painted over with no refund given. Judgment on appropriateness will be at the sole discretion of the school administration.

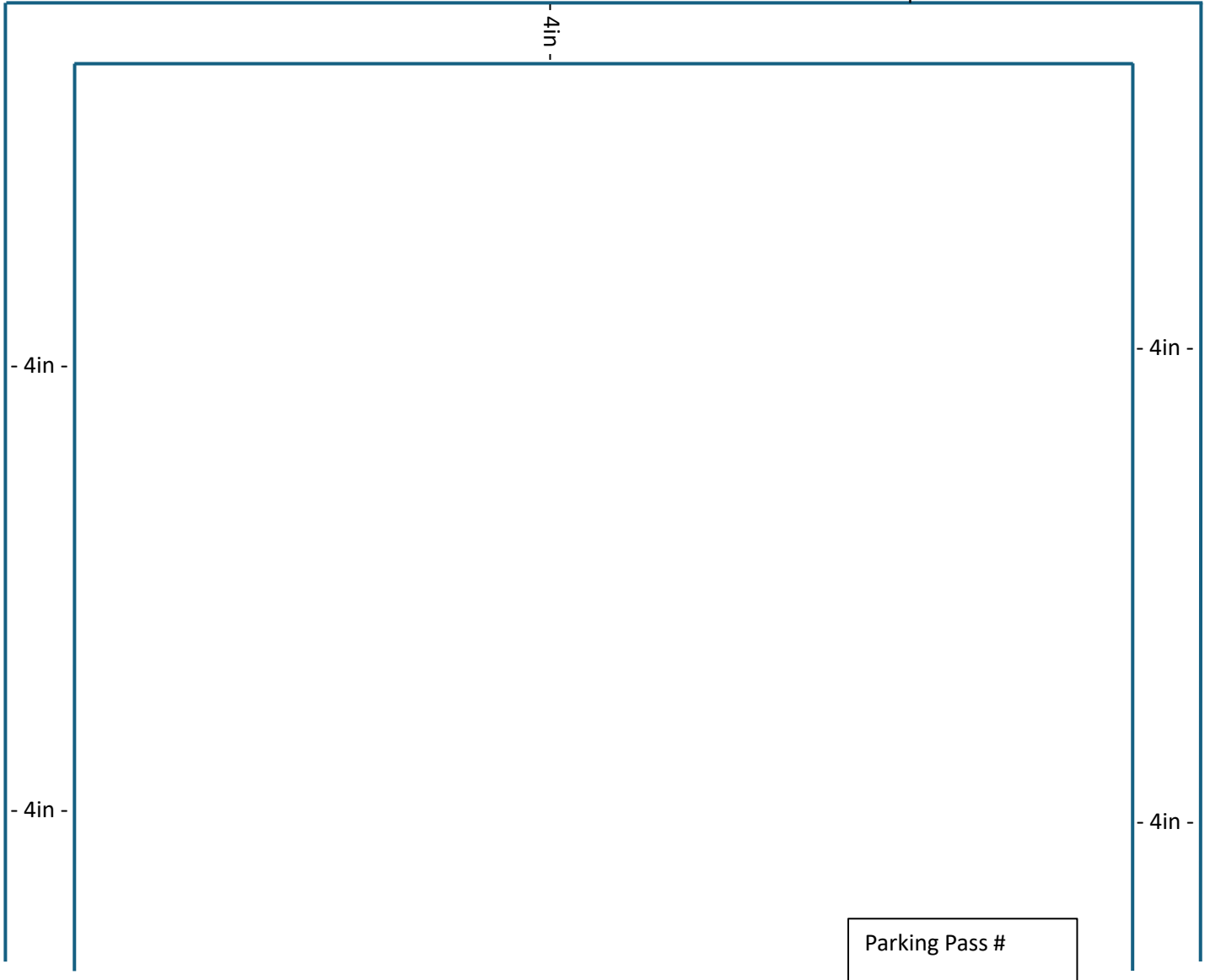
